

# Police Activity in Greenslopes Subdivision, September 2009 - February 2010

## NOTES

This map shows the streets that are included in the analysis. Included are the 700-1400 blocks of Lawnmont; the 300-1400 blocks of Logan; and the 200-1200 blocks of Greenlawn. The data source is the Police Department's Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD) database. That means the data are drawn from the information police dispatchers enter into the computer as calls occur.

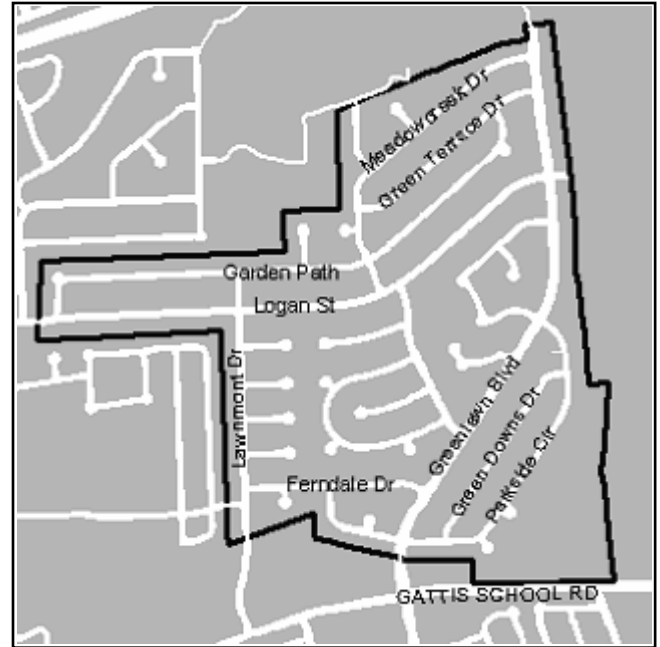
The primary limitation of these data is that they may not reflect the actual nature of a call or its true final disposition. Thus, some care should be exercised in interpreting the results presented here.

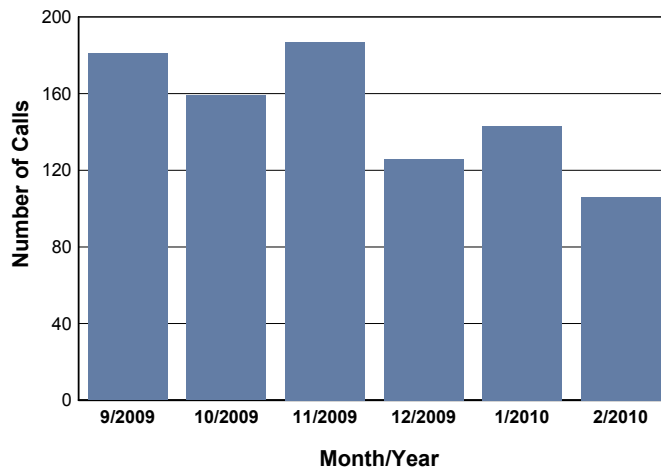

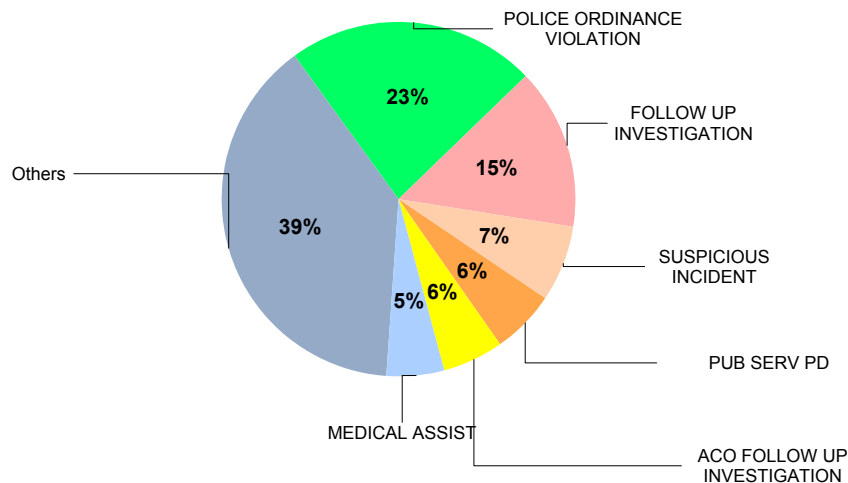

Call dispositions are organized into the following categories: Arrest Made, Cancelled/False Alarm, No Report, Report Taken, Referred (to Other Agency), Unable to Locate, and Warning or Ticket Issued. If a category does not appear in the table above, then no calls resulted in that disposition category during the period in question.
