8	WHEREAS, On June 29, 2020, the City Council declared, pursuant to Section									
9	3.14 of the Round Rock Home Rule Charter, that a public health emergency existed in									
10	the City of Round Rock due to the COVID-19 pandemic and adopted Emergency									
11	Ordinance No. O-2020-0374 regarding face covering requirements; and									
12	WHEREAS, Emergency Ordinance No. O-2020-0374 was most recently									
13	renewed for an additional sixty (60) days by Ordinance No. O-2021-060 on February 25									
14	2021; and									
15	WHEREAS, the expected number of Williamson County residents fully									
16	vaccinated by the end of the month has increased to over 33% of those over the age of									
17	16 and 65% of those over 65; and									
18	WHEREAS, all three vaccines approved for Emergency Use Authorization (EUA)									
19	by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in the United States are available to the									
20	general public in Texas; and									
21	WHEREAS, the sustained COVID-19 hospitalization rate in Trauma Service Area									
22	O (TSA-O) has remained at roughly 5%, with a statistically average number of hospita									
23	beds being available in Williamson County; and									
24	WHEREAS, as a result of increase in vaccinations and a decrease in									
25	hospitalizations, the City Council desires to repeal Emergency Ordinance O-2020-0374									
26	Now therefore,									

1	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK,									
2	TEXAS:

4	That Emergency Ordinance O-2020-0374 regarding face coverings is hereby									
5	repealed effective 11:59 P.M. on April 22, 2021.

7	A. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are									
8	expressly repealed.									
9	B. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not									
10	invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.									
11	C. The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date,									
12	hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was posted									
13	and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during									
14	which this Ordinance and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and									
15	formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas									
16	Government Code, as amended.
