## **Round Rock Veterans Monument**

The Round Rock Veterans Monument was built by the City of Round as a place of honor and remembrances for all that are serving or have served to protect and defend our American heritage. It is where veterans can show their pride for having served; families and friends can honor their veterans for their service; and citizens and businesses can support the recognition of those with a historical attachment to Round Rock.

The Round Rock Veterans Monument is located on Pecan Street at Veterans Park and features six columns with plaques that honor the different service branches: Army, Marine Corp, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, and Merchant Marines. A Memorial Wall honoring veterans who have been killed in action, held as a prisoner of war, or declared missing in action is at the center of the Monument. In 2019, the Round Rock Veterans Monument was expanded to include six new columns, where all new veterans plaques will be installed. New plaques are 4 1/2"W x 2"H with a brushed aluminum finish.

#### Process for recognizing a veteran

Fill out the form located on the back side of the back of this page. The purchase price of a veteran's plaque is \$60.00. This will cover a portion of the total cost of purchase and installation of the veteran's plaque. The remaining cost is paid for by generous Round Rock donors.
