Sh2-190 - Heart Nebula

About this work: The Heart Nebula, officially designated Sh2-190, is a vibrant emission nebula located in the constellation Cassiopeia, roughly 7,500 light-years away. It spans about 200 light-years across and is named for its striking resemblance to a human heart in astrophotographs.

IC 63 - The Ghost of Cassiopeia

About this work: Another cool nebula in the constellation Cassiopeia is often called the Ghost of Cassiopeia. It's an emission nebula, but most of its brightness comes from the light of Gamma Cassiopeia, the fourth star in the constellation. This object isn't super far away either at only about ~550 ly from us.

NGC 1499 - The California Nebula

About this work: The California Nebula (NGC 1499) is a large emission nebula in the constellation Perseus and can be found near the Pleiades in the Fall/Winter sky. It has a low surface brightness, so it's hard to visually observe when compared to other bright nebulas like Orion.
